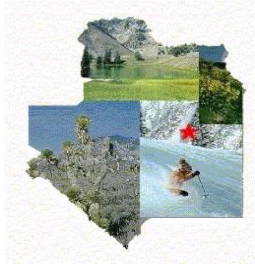

About the Position

The Carson Ranger District is looking to fill a Winter OSV(Over Snow Vehicle) position. The position will serve as an OSV Ranger conducting snowmobile patrol in the Carson Ranger District OSV areas. The day to day activities will include; back country snowmobile patrol, OSV education, wilderness boundary signing, and enforcement of all OSV regulations and requirements. Work schedule will be Thursday through Monday. Barricks will be available at the Plymouth Work Center located in Carson City, NV if needed. Please indicate if you are a Forest Protection Officer (FPO), have snowmobile riding experience, back country winter experience, and any avalanche training.

About the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest

The Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, in the Intermountain Region, has 6.5 million acres of mountains and valleys, ranging from 2,000 to nearly 13,000 feet high. It is the largest National Forest in the contiguous United States. The H-T National Forest is divided into Ranger Districts with offices at Carson City, Austin, Tonopah, Elko, Ely, Wells and Las Vegas, Nevada and in Bridgeport, California. The Forest Supervisor's Office is located at 1200 Franklin Way, Sparks, Nevada which is in the Reno-Sparks Metropolitan area.
