- Building maintenance (sweep, mop, vacuum, dust, paint, windows, etc.)
- Spawning and sorting fish. Assist in the sorting, tagging and marking of fish. Fish loading and planting. Fish feeding. Assist in all spawning practices. Keeps records of fish handled and spawned.
- Hatchery duties (assists with trough set up for the incubation of eggs and early rearing of fish, cleaning of troughs and egg picking, etc.)
- State vehicle and equipment maintenance (wash and wax vehicles, lube and service small power equipment)
